Cook Off Set Up

1. Teams will be allowed 2 parking spaces deep, and 2 parking spaces wide for a total of 4 parking spaces each as shown. Any additional vehicles not within the 4 spaces will not be permitted to stay on the lot. There will be a designated parking area for additional vehicles.
2. Teams will be set up in the order they arrive following the yellow arrows with the first to arrive in the far north spot at the front of the lot. The next team will be set up in the next 4 spots and so on. Once the first row has been filled, teams will then be set up in the second row following the black arrows with the first team in the far south spot at the back of the lot.
3. There will not be any reserving or saving spots as this has caused difficulty setting up in the past. To make everything go smoother we ask that if you want to park by a buddy make plans to follow each other in.
4. There will be no parking allowed in the outside parking spaces of the lot. These spaces are to remain open to serve as a fire lane in the event of an emergency.
5. Water will be available at the fill station located at the north end of the lot. We recommend filling up as you arrive. Should you need more water later we will have someone who will take your containers and fill them for you.
6. Electricity will be provided. Service hook-ups are 30 amp.
7. Porta-Potties will be located on the north and south sides of the lot.
8. Grease, coal, and gray water containers will be located at the north side of the lot.
9. Teams will be given 2 free bags of ice. Additional ice will be available for purchase.
10. After the award ceremony Saturday, teams will be required to clear the lot by 6:00pm for garbage cleanup and tear down of the generators.
11. The cooks meeting will be held at 5:00pm in the judges tent located on the north side of the road just north of the lot.
12. Turn-in will be located outside of the judges tent and times are those that follow KCBS guidelines.
